



CHILD & ADOLESCENT SUPPORT SERVICES (CASS)

Community Resource Center is offering free comprehensive services to children and adolescents under the age of 18:

- Individual Counseling
- Group Counseling
- Crisis Intervention
- Case management
- Treatment plan meetings with parents/caregivers
- Criminal justice system orientation
- Transportation services to psychotherapy and/or criminal justice-related activities
- Family therapy is also available for family members as part of the child's treatment.

Eligibility: Counseling services are available for children under 18 and their caregivers that:

- have been victims of crime
- have experienced abuse and/or neglect
- have been exposed to domestic violence
- have been exposed to parental substance abuse, child abduction
- witnessed a crime or violence in the school or community
- are dependents of the court and involved in the child welfare system

Additional eligibility includes:

- Children who are non-English speaking
- Children with disabilities
- Children of racial and ethnic minorities
- LGBTQ children
- Children who have been removed from their homes and placed in the emergency shelter programs
- non-offending family members/caregivers of child victims

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
