Support Services Include:

An individual agreement provides subsidized rent and support including:

- Credit Report Fees
- Rental Application Fees
- Utility Deposit Fees
- Apartment furnishings
- Case Management
- Individual, group, and family counseling
- Legal Advocacy
- Transportation assistance
- Budgeting assistance
- Employment Assistance

Eligibility Guidelines:

- Families fleeing/attempting to flee Domestic Violence, has no other residence, and lacks the resources or support networks to obtain other permanent housing.
- Desire to reach financial independence
- Willing to break free from the cycle of violence
- Able to safely live independently
- Completion of housing and safety plan
